REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION:

Eligibility: Contestants must be between ages 5 to 18 years old. Past grand prize winners are excluded.

<u>Categories:</u> 1. Piano Solo, 2. Strings, 3. Chamber Music (group of 3-5 performers for division B only)

<u>Divisions:</u> A) age 5-11 years old; B) age 12-18 years old

Prize and Performance Award: One Grand Prize Winner will be selected among a total of 5 awards to receive the Asian American Community Partnership Challenge Cup. One winner will be chosen from each division and category. All winners will be awarded a special appearance performance to benefit a local nonprofit organization. The event will be held on Saturday May 26th, 2018, at the Austin Asian Occasion, to also celebrate the Asian & Asian Pacific American Heritage Month. All winners are required to perform in order to receive scholarship prizes. Honorable mention certificates will be given at Judges' discretion. All winners will also receive two complimentary tickets to the May concert.

<u>Audition:</u> April 14th and 15th, 2018 (Saturday and Sunday). <u>Contestants and their accompanists are required to be available at the assigned audition time.</u> Judges' decision is final. Critiques will be mailed to the applicant's teacher. Audition will take place at **Asian American Cultural Center,** 11713 Jollyville Road, Austin, TX, 78759

Repertoire: One or more standard original music compositions that do not exceed 10 minutes in total playing time. No transcriptions or arrangements will be accepted. If two works are to be performed, contrasting style is required. Judges reserve the right to stop the performance if exceeding the allowed playing time. All applicants must perform the music from memory and provide their own piano accompanists. Chamber Music Category contestants (3-5 players for division B only) are allowed to perform from music.
